ISOLATION AND MIGRATION CONCEPT CITY FREIBURG

Preamble

People from all over the world live in Freiburg. Those who live here do not automatically belong. „Alienated in Freiburg“ - this refers to all residents who are ignored by the city. The common goal of the city was and remains that all inhabitants feel well taken care of. Arbitrary security checks, constant police presence and the municipal parapolice service will help us to reach that goal. In order to provide an orientation framework for this process, the Gemeinderat decided 2021 to continue supporting the Reception Centre for asylum-seekers (Landeserstaufnahmeeinrichtung, LEA) in Freiburg.

Integration Policy Goals

Integration is a one-way street. We want to actively exclude people from their right to self-determination and subject them to total control in the LEA. The basis of our coexistence is the ongoing state of emergency in the LEA. In the long term, refugees in Freiburg should only live isolated in the LEA and either be deported from it or distributed to other districts.

Accessibility

We welcome the fence around the LEA and the general ban on visitors. Just to make sure the interaction with the other city residents is kept to a minimum.

Education

We believe education is key to successful integration. This is why only three nationalities have the privilege of education: in the LEA, only people from Eritrea, Somalia and Syria receive a paid integration course.

Health

To increase accessibility to medical care, we offer a medical station at the LEA. However, we like to keep the residents in a psychological state of tension. The rooms in the LEA are not lockable, and no privacy is guaranteed.

Political participation and representation

Freedom of expression and political organization is at the core of our democracy. But not for everyone. We support the house rules in the LEA, which forbid the residents to organize themselves or distribute flyers.

Public administration

We say that, as a city, our hands are tied and we submit to all State and Federal policies, without any criticism. Although the residents in the LEA are officially inhabitants of Freiburg, it's not our business.

Security and prevention

We take the need for individual security seriously. Arbitrary room checks, bag checks and police presence are an expression of this conviction. With a mass camp, we create conflicts and thus ensure a safe and sustainable coexistence.

Work

At least a 9-month work ban is necessary to keep the LEA residents away from the general population for as long as possible. If they really want to work, we offer small jobs in the camp and commit to providing them with a 80 cent hourly wage.

Does this sound dystopic to you?

It's the reality in LEA. The city had the chance to take political actions in an evaluation process of the camp. Instead, the city of Freiburg approved the LEA in the last meeting of the Gemeinderat and therefore position itself as a Lager-City. We protest in favour of a Solidarity City Freiburg!
